1. Enclosure (1) was developed to assist in the deployment of CHCS II. This guidance is intended for use by your CHCS II Project Officer and Clinical Champion to assist them in the integration of the system into MTF clinical and business processes. The training guide explains in detail the use of CHCS II in various settings from the clinical encounter to the referral management process.
2. The guide should also be made available to your CHCS II users as it answers many frequently asked questions. The index to the appendices on page 16 is an active index, allowing users to jump to any topic on the index with a simple mouse click.
3. Prior to finalization, this guide was reviewed by MTF Clinical Champions in small, medium and large commands and by a number of subject matter experts in Navy Medicine. We incorporated their recommendations in the final product.
