Consult Log



- Wish you could track the status of your consults in AHLTA? Want to be able to easily view the notes from completed consults in a single location?
- Consult Log provides an easy to use menu to track status of consults to include being able to see:
 - Status of consult (has it been booked, has patient been seen, did patient no-show)
 - Access completed consult notes easily
 - Way to see all consults and pertinent information easily (reason for consult, location of consult)
- Important that patient consult appointments are booked against the ordered consult in CHCS or else information won't be available.


