Single Sign On to View VA Data

- Do you wish that you could view Veteran Administration data on your patient without logging into a different system and retyping the patient's information to search for them?
- Are you tired of having to remember a ZILLION and eight password just to care for the patient?
- You have the ability to see VA information specific to your patient from AHLTA today, provided the patient has ever been registered in CHCS at your facility. (Only one zillion and 7 passwords left to reduce 😊)
- This Pearl will show you how to use the feature.

The Outpatient Medications Details page displays the patient's active, inactive, discontinued, and expired outpatient medications information from the VA for the previous 18 months in reverse chronological order by Fill Date. The user can re-sort the data by clicking a different column header.

The Fill Data only displays the last fill date for a medication; previous fill dates will not be displayed.

The Status column indicates whether the prescription is Active (Statuses = Refill, Fill, Warning, Active, Hold, and Partial) or Inactive (Statuses = Renewed, Expired, or Discontinued).

- For some patients, it takes a while to load all the information. So click and do something else, or call the VA or your release of information staff to see if you can get the information faster 😊.
