

How to Use the Consult Log in AHLTA versions 837 & 838

The consult log function of AHLTA is a useful tool to track consults that you may have submitted to others, or that you have completed for another provider. It is now the default way for providers to access the results of a consult that was previously sent (there will be very few CHCS-legacy e-mails any longer).

The following is a brief walk-through of the consult log, with screenshots, to assist you in using this tool.

1. Open the Consult Log.

This is done as shown below, clicking on the "Consult Log" icon in the folder list

2. Change the display options.

The current default is to show all consults submitted by you or to you that have appointments today. To change the display, click on the “Change Selections...” or “Options” button. Unfortunately, the consult log does not currently save the default settings for how you would like to view consults if you attempt to change the Appointment Dates:

The boxes are fairly self explanatory. Here is a brief explanation, with recommended settings for getting the results of consults requested:

a. **Consults For.** You can choose consults that were submitted by you to another specialty, or you can select the consults that were submitted to you. Recommendation: [Consults From Me](#)

b. **Consult Status Selection.** This option allows you to narrow the field based upon whether the consult as been completed, appointed, or any of the other options. Recommendation: [Completed](#)

c. **Appointment Dates.** When the patient was seen in the consultant's clinic. Choosing all will list all appointments available in AHLTA. You can also choose to display consults for which an appointment has not been made.
Recommendation: [Use date range to select past 2-4 weeks \(or shorter based upon your frequency of checking the log\)](#)

d. **Consult Order Dates.** The date the consult was entered into the system. The system defaults to the past month. This is ok if the patient gets seen within a month of the consult request, but sometimes that doesn't happen. Choosing all dates will ensure you don't miss a consult. Recommendation: [All](#)

e. **Optional Fields.** If you want any of this data displayed once a new log is generated, you can choose these. Believe the warning that it will slow down the load time, so only choose one of these if you really, really need that information.
Recommendation: [Leave all unselected](#)

Once you are happy with the choices you have made, click ok to get the new log (example below). Just remember that the current version of AHLTA will not save any of these options as defaults, you must take the time to change each time you view the consult log.
